October 2012, **FotoFocus**, a nonprofit arts organization celebrating and championing the ubiquity of photography and its important role in contemporary culture, launches its first biennial month-long regional celebration of historical and contemporary photography and lens-based art. The

FotoFocus biennial presents an unprecedented opportunity to learn about and experience the diverse currents of photography. **FotoFocus** brings together museums, galleries, and universities showcasing world-renowned artists and national and regional standouts. Pop-up venues, community art centers, and other grass roots organizations explore current trends in photography with exhibitions featuring the work of emerging talents and students.

FotoFocus recaptures the spirit of Cincinnati's legacy as an epicenter of art production, collaboration, and creative exchange, and seeks to revitalize and rebuild that spirit for the 21st century. Participating venues include: the Cincinnati Art Museum, the Contemporary Arts Center, and the Taft Museum of Art, and other institutional partners such as Northern Kentucky University, Ohio University's Kennedy Museum, the University of Cincinnati, and Miami University, the Weston Art Gallery, the Carnegie Arts Center, the Mercantile Library, the Architectural Foundation of Cincinnati, the Art Academy of Cincinnati, as well as 21c Museum Hotel, Country Club, Carl Solway Gallery, Prairie, Carnegie Visual and Performing Arts Center, among others.

The FotoFocus concert is presented by *CityBeat*, independent and locally owned by Lightborne Publishing since 1994. Lightborne publications and events include *CityBeat* newspaper, *A-Line* magazine, CityBeat.com, BestOfCincinnati.com and the annual MidPoint Music Festival. *CityBeat* is the winner of multiple awards as Ohio's best weekly newspaper.
